Offer a wide variety of general purpose native meadow mixes, mostly perennial with three annuals. Flowers can be purchased together or as individual species allowing you to design your own meadow mix.  
The Urban Pollinator Project uses 'EN1F Special Pollen and Nectar Wildflowers' mix in their perennial meadows

Offer a variety of annual and perennial mixes both native and non-native. Meadow mixes suitable for a wide range of habitats from waste ground to green roofs. Their meadow mixes have been used at both the Olympic stadium and the Eden Project. Seeds can be purchased in bulk or as individual packets.

The 'Pollinators Paradise' mix contains a range of annual and perennial seeds that will provide a continuous supply of pollen and nectar from spring through to early autumn.

If you would like something more instant you can also purchase a variety of plug plants that allow you to quickly establish a wildflower area within your garden.
