* Salary scales for doctors and dentists in training were originally increased by 6% to basic pay plus an additional consolidated increase of £1,250 to each pay point from 1 April 2023.

** Following agreement with the Westminster Government these have been further increased to reflect increased values to the nodal points and an additional 3.71% to the pay scales for pre-2009 and post-2009 Clinical Lecturer scales. These new pay uplifts are effective from 1 April 2023.

***The salary scales for doctors and dentists in training (as revised effective from 1 April 2023, as above) have been increased by 6% to basic pay, plus a consolidated increase of £1,000 with effect from 1 April 2024.
