APPLYING TO BRISTOL

Entry requirements

We accept a wide range of qualifications. You can find specific entry requirements on individual course pages online. The table below will give you an idea of the typical requirements for each study level.

Postgraduate taught (Master's: MSc, MA, MRes, LLM)	Undergraduate (bachelor's) degree, equivalent to a UK upper second-class degree (also known as a 2:1)	bristol.ac.uk/postgraduate
Postgraduate research (PhD)	Master's degree, with grade requirements ranging from 75% to 85% depending on the institution	bristol.ac.uk/postgraduate

English language requirements

If your first language is not English, you will need to show proof of your English language ability. We accept a wide range of qualifications and tests. Different courses need different English language levels. Specific requirements are listed on individual course pages online.
