Pay increase for GP teachers!

1% Increase in payment rates to practices

The restructuring of teaching due to MB21, the new undergraduate curriculum, is providing us with opportunities to restructure payments for primary care teaching within our existing budget. From September 2017, we will be increasing the rate we pay to all practices by 1%. Not as much as we would like, but a step in the right direction.


