Bristol medical school is undertaking a review of the entire undergraduate curriculum to take account of societal, medical and teaching changes. The amount and content of science teaching will be reviewed as Medicine is shifting from a knowledge-based to a problem-solving profession. This will have a **major impact on Primary Care teaching**. There is a general drive by the GMC for more medical student teaching to be delivered in Primary Care. The new curriculum will come into effect in 2017.

It is important that all our GP Teachers have a say in this and we have therefore organised a curriculum event for GP Teachers on Tuesday 8th September at the Engineers' Hse, Clifton, Bristol.
