
Reception Room



Car Parking:

By Train:

Bristol Temple Meads is the closest main train station, 1.2 miles and a 25-minute walk away from the venue. Alternatively, you can use local buses or an e-scooter to transport you to the venue.

By Local Bus:

Several bus services stop a short walk away from the Queens Building:

- Services 1, 2, 2a, 8 and 72 all run from Temple
 Meads train station, services 3 and 4 run from the city centre. Alight at Park Street Top
- Service U1 operates term-time only and runs from Stoke Bishop. Alight at Queen's Avenue.
