TNA E190/1132/11 is the account of the surveyor for the overseas trade of Bristol during the period Michaelmas 1600 to Michaelmas 1601.

It contains the same level of detail as the 1594/5 account. Again, a detailed comparison of the surveyor and controller accounts for the same period raises questions about the level of independence involved in the creation of these records. An interesting example, found on f31r., shows both officials listing goods, that when totalled using EXCEL, come to the modern equivalent of £28.92, while both accounts give a total value of £29.92, which suggests that they are both missing an item, or items, of the same value, and indicates copying at some point in the recording procedure.¹ Where any missing items have been identified in this comparative examination of the accounts they have been imputed into this transcription and are clearly identified as such.
