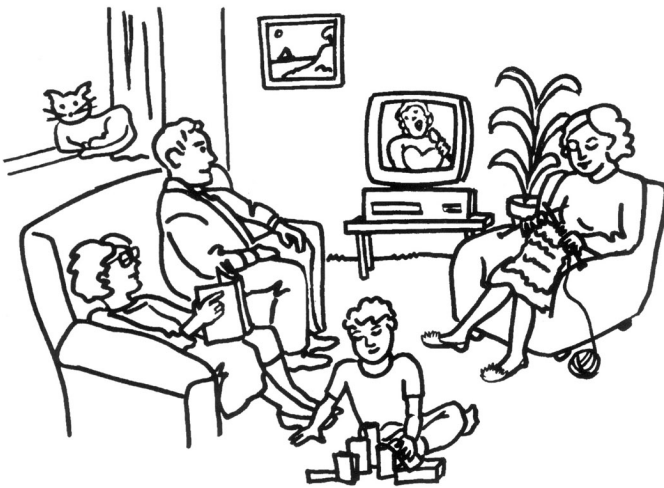


Plain facts
