

Accommodation Guarantee 2021/22

Covid-19: update on our accommodation guarantee

For your safety and wellbeing, we may need to change how we allocate students to our residences for the 2021/22 academic year.

Depending on the UK's Coronavirus risk level, some residences and room types may not be available for the 2021/22 academic year, and we therefore reserve the right to amend our accommodation guarantee if required for safety reasons.

We guarantee an offer of University-allocated accommodation for the first year of study to all UK, EU and International undergraduates who apply by 30 July 2021, provided that they:

- have firmly accepted an offer of study at Bristol (this means you need to put Bristol as your first choice to be guaranteed accommodation),
- are coming to study at Bristol for the first time (this means you are not a returner or have not suspended your studies previously),
- are unaccompanied (this means you are coming without dependent family members, spouses or partners).

The guarantee does not apply to students who:

- miss the application deadline,
- have not firmly accepted their offer of study by 30 July 2021,
- have previously studied at the University of Bristol,
- are [Erasmus students](#).

Please note that to fulfil our guarantee we may make you an offer for a room that is not in one of our advertised residences, or in a room shared with another student.
