## **EVALUATION FORM CONCLUSIONS**

- 1. 38% of the participants returned a completed evaluation form.
- 2. The conference was considered a success in terms of content and organisation (over 90% +/++ in both cases).
- 3. The theme was considered very relevant for the ongoing discussions on the role of universities in shaping the European research area (95%).
- 4. Among the keynote speakers, Professor José Mariano Gago's presentation was the most appreciated.
- 5. The discussion groups were evaluated very positively, although the groups on the Saturday morning were more positively assessed than those of Friday afternoon (81% / 61%).
- 6. The vast majority of participants thought that the programme adequately handled the topic (82%).
- 7. More than one third of the participants (36%) indicated that they would initiate changes in their institutions and launch collaboration projects with other participants as a direct consequence of their conference participation..
- 8. The conference reached its goal in creating a better understanding of the issues involved in discussing the role, universities could play in the creation of a European research area, and in making university leaders consider changes by obtaining information and comparing examples of good practice.
