

Classification in Engineering in 2021/22 and subsequent years

The below temporary amendment to regulations applies to students on undergraduate programmes in the Faculty of Engineering who were affected by the cancellation and rescheduling of the assessment for the Engineering Mathematics 2 (EMAT20200) unit in 2020/21, when their degree is considered for classification in 2021/22 and subsequent years. The existing regulations on the award of a qualification are not affected and apply in the normal way.

- Where a student elected **not** to take the rescheduled assessment for the Engineering Mathematics 2 (EMAT20200) unit later in 2020/21 and they progressed from the year of study by the end of the 2020/21 academic year, the unit mark will be **disregarded** from calculating degree classification where it provides a higher classification for the student.
 - Normal regulations for classification apply where the EMAT20200 unit is completed in 2021/22 or subsequent years.
- 2. Where a student elected to take the rescheduled assessment for the Engineering Mathematics 2 (EMAT20200) unit later in the 2020/21 academic year and they progressed from the year of study, the unit mark will be **included** in calculating the degree classification, except where the unit mark is less than the individual student's year mark for their second year of study, in which case it will be disregarded from classification.
- 3. Where a unit mark is disregarded, the year mark retains its weighting for the purposes of classification. The unit does not contribute to the conditions for classification (section 3) set out in the <u>temporary regulations for classification from 2021/22 for students who completed units on intermediate years of study in 2019/20 and 2020/21</u>.
