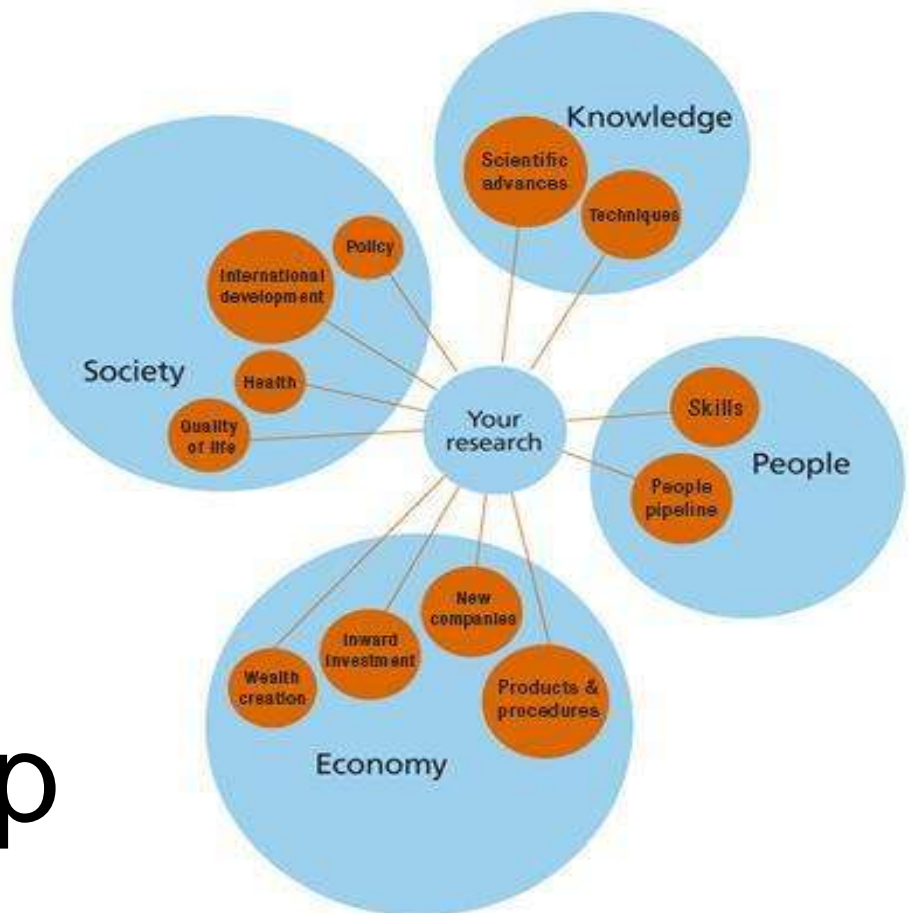


Developing impact in the natural sciences
