The group is called the **Cleft@18-23 PPI Group**. PPI stands for **Patient & Public Involvement**. It is a way of making sure that research is designed, planned and carried out with the people that the research will have an impact on.

As part of the **Cleft@18-23** PPI group, we will:

- offer you some training on what PPI is and what we will be doing as part of the group
- ask if you can help us to write the information about the project in a way that young adults will understand
- discuss ways of getting that information to the right people
- discuss the results of the projects and how they might relate to your own experiences
- think about how to share the results and help to share them
- thank you for your help with vouchers (£25 per hour of activity)
