You will gain a breadth of knowledge across all the main low carbon energy technologies and how they can be effectively integrated in modern day energy systems. During the Masters you will also gain specialist knowledge of designing wind and solar energy devices, applying this to real-world case studies using state-of-the-art commercial software.

What will you study?

You'll study a number of joint core units to enhance your leadership skills plus specialist technical units to suit your aspirations.

Joint core units:

- Engineering Design and Technology
- Systems Risk Management
- Interdisciplinary Research Skills

Pathway specialist units:

- Renewable Energy for a Sustainable Future
- Wind Energy Systems

The dissertation is a core unit where you will work on a project in the field of engineering management relevant to your pathway.

The course content is designed and delivered in partnership with industry and as a result, graduates from the pathway will have excellent career prospects. Potential job roles range from energy consultancy to research and development positions linked to future renewable energy technologies.
