



Bristol Big Give 'What to give where'

Please recycle as much as possible when you are moving out. The Bristol Heart Foundation (BHF) will have recycling bins around campus and in nearby residential areas. Bristol Waste will be providing large bins for extra waste that cannot be recycled.

If you are moving from your house and have a lot of items to dispose of, and you have access to transport, you can take your items to a Recycling Centre: Recycling centres - Bristol Waste

Company for free and without booking in May and June- but you must take your Student ID.

If you have space at your property you can also hire a big bin: <u>Bin hire for students and landlords - Bristol Waste Company</u>

Item	How to recycle	
Food	 Plan ahead & use up any food before you leave. Long-life food (eg tinned food) at least 6 months before best before date can be donated to foodbanks at your local supermarket. Take any other unused food with you, or put out in your brown food waste bin wrapped in newspaper or in a compostable bag. 	
Bedding	 Duvets & pillows <u>cannot</u> be reused for health & safety reasons and need to be taken with you or disposed of as general waste. Duvet covers, sheets and pillowcases can be donated to the <u>BHF bins</u>. 	
Household goods (no knives)	Brick-a-brac and clean, good quality, saleable kitchenware can be donated to the BHF bins.	
Electrical Items	Small usable electrical items (eg hair tongs, hairdryers, gaming equipment etc) can be donated to BHF bins.	
Clothes/Shoes	 Any wearable clothes or shoes can be sold or donated to the Big Give BHF bins Any clothes which are no longer wearable need to be disposed of in your general waste. Clothes hangers cannot be recycled. 	
Laptops (Not Apples)	Windows laptops (not Apples) can be donated at DigiLocal collection points, with a donation form: Laptop Donations – digilocal.org.uk.	
Mobile phones	Oxfam shops will take mobile phones for recycling/re-use. Find your local Oxfam Shop Shop Finder Oxfam GB	
Sofas, mattresses & other furniture	 Reusable sofas with fire safety tags and other useable furniture may be collected by <u>BHF or other charities</u>. If your old furniture cannot be re-used you can pay to get these picked up: <u>Bulky household item collection (bristol.gov.uk)</u> 	
Bicycles	Cycles can be donated to <u>Lifecycle</u> or <u>Bristol Bike Project</u>	

Other places you can donate usable items:

Charity Shops: If the BHF boxes are full there are lots of charity shops to donate to on Whiteladies Road, Cotham Hill and Park Road. Please check what they will take first.

Bulky waste/furniture: The following charities may also take re-usable furniture items for free (please check what they can collect first):

Items that cannot be recycled:

If there are items that you cannot recycle (eg clothes hangers, used duvets and pillows) these need to be disposed of as general waste.

Please plan ahead so you do not have too much waste for your black wheelie bins. Leaving waste next to your wheelie bins is fly tipping. You can be fined up to £400 by the Council.

If you have access to transport you will be able to take any additional waste, along with your recycling, to a Reuse & Recycling Centre: Recycling centres - Bristol Waste Company for free. If you take your Student ID card during May and June you do not need to book.
