Entry requirements

English language requirements

If you are not a national of an English-speaking country (as listed in our English language profiles) you will need to show proof of your English language ability. We accept a wide range of qualifications and tests which are listed on our English language profile pages.

School qualifications from some EU countries can be used to meet English language requirements. Courses have different requirements, and more information can be found on our course pages online.
