Entry requirements

We accept a wide range of qualifications. You can find specific entry requirements on individual course pages online. The table below will give you an idea of the typical requirements for each study level.

Postgraduate taught (Master's: MSc, MA, MRes, LLM)	Bachelor's degree from an accepted Indian university with a minimum of GPA of 6/10 or 60% (the requirement will depend on undergraduate university and programme applied for) Applicants to Law programmes can be considered with minimum grades of 55-60% from an accepted Indian university A list of accepted universities is available on our website	bristol.ac.uk/postgraduate
Postgraduate research (PhD)	First class Indian bachelor's degree and some research experience; master's degree with research elements is desirable	bristol.ac.uk/postgraduate
Global Transfer Programme (Bachelor's/master's)	If you are a student at one of our partner universities, you may be eligible to apply to Bristol via our Global Transfer Programme	bristol.ac.uk/transfer

English language requirements

You will need to show proof of your English language ability. We accept a wide range of qualifications and tests which are listed on our English language profile pages. Courses have different requirements, and more information can be found on our course pages online.

CBSE or CISCE English, as well as English from some state boards, can be accepted in lieu of another English test such as IELTS. Please check the English language profile pages for more information on grade requirements.
