## Entry requirements

We accept a wide range of qualifications. You can find specific entry requirements on individual course pages online. The table below will give you an idea of the typical requirements for each study level.

## English language requirements

You will need to show proof of your English language ability. We accept a wide range of qualifications and tests – including the Singapore Integrated Programme, Singapore Ordinary Level, Singapore Secondary 4 and Singapore NUS Integrated Diploma – which are listed on our English language profile pages. Courses have different requirements, and more information can be found on our course pages online.
