Bristol Students' Union runs regular events, starting from Welcome Week, for you to find friends and build your community.

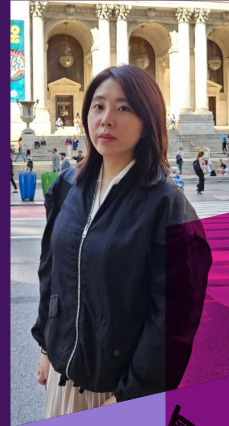
Inspirational alumni
