APPLYING TO BRISTOL

Entry requirements

We accept a wide range of qualifications. You can find specific entry requirements on individual course pages online. The table below will give you an idea of the typical requirements for each study level.

Degree type	Accepted qualifications	More information
Undergraduate (Bachelor's: BA, BEng, BSc, BDS, BVSc, LLB, MArts, MEng, MSci, MBChB)	One of the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• CBSE or CISCE qualifications, typically 80-90%• A-levels: typically AAA or higher• International Baccalaureate Diploma (IB): typically 36 points or higher Other qualifications such as state board certificates are accepted; contact us for details	bristol.ac.uk/undergraduate
Postgraduate taught (Master's: MSc, MA, MRes, LLM)	First class degree (60% or higher) or first class with distinction from a recognised Indian university; 55% pass may be accepted from some top colleges	bristol.ac.uk/postgraduate
Postgraduate research (PhD)	First class Indian bachelor's degree and some research experience; master's degree with research elements is desirable	bristol.ac.uk/postgraduate
Global Transfer Programme (Bachelor's and master's)	Students at one of our partner universities may be eligible to apply. This programme provides guaranteed offers and exclusive funding opportunities	bristol.ac.uk/transfer

English language requirements

If your first language is not English, you will need to show proof of your English language ability. We accept a wide range of qualifications and tests. Different courses need different English language levels. Specific requirements are listed on individual course pages online.

We understand that the majority of candidates from India have been taught in English throughout their education. For undergraduate applicants, CBSE or CISCE English at 70-80% or above can be accepted in lieu of another English test such as IELTS. For postgraduate applicants, many departments will accept CBSE or CISCE English at 80% or above in lieu of another English test, with an MOI letter confirming that English is the teaching language of your institution.

Scholarships

Our Think Big scholarship scheme supports international students from around the world. We are investing £3 million in University of Bristol scholarships for overseas students in 2024.
