

Guy Davidov is the Elias Lieberman Professor of Labour Law at the Hebrew University of Jerusalem. He was the founder and first Chair of the Labour Law Research Network (2011-2015). He was also the Editor-in-Chief of the International Journal of Comparative Labour Law and Industrial Relations (2015-2020). His book A Purposive Approach to Labour Law was published by OUP in 2016. He has also co-edited (with Brian Langille) two influential books, Boundaries and Frontiers of Labour Law (Hart, 2006) and The Idea of Labour Law (Oxford UP, 2011). He is currently editing (with Brian Langille and Gillian Lester) the Oxford Handbook of the Law of Work. His articles appeared in the Oxford Journal of Legal Studies, the Modern Law Review, the University of Toronto Law Journal, Law & Social Inquiry, Industrial Law Journal, the Comparative Labour Law & Policy Journal and more.
