The University of Bristol Law Clinic provides legal advice and support to members of the public, under the supervision of Law School staff members. The Law Clinic gives students first-hand experience of law in practice: students will work on real cases and be responsible for all areas of case management. This includes conducting the case research, liaising with clients and even going to a court or tribunal. Our partnership with international firm Osborne Clarke provides students with training and guidance from legal professionals, enabling students to work confidently and professionally to ensure our clients receive the advice and support that they need.

WHAT ARE WE LOOKING FOR

We are looking for students with a real interest in gaining practical legal experience and who have the drive and organisation to manage Law Clinic alongside their studies and other considerations. Being a member of the Law Clinic is an enjoyable and rewarding role, but one that comes with responsibilities.
