Who are these for?

Anyone, but especially those without experience of publishing or who would like to share and build on the experience they have. Please email for the link for each session. You don't have to attend all, pick what will be most useful to you. The focus will be on publishing education research although all sessions are about transferable skills.

Session one: Journal articles, getting started.

What have I done that can I write about? How do I choose a journal? What skills do I need? Should I write on my own or with others? How do I know what the journal wants me to do? What else can I do to prepare?

Session two: Journal articles, writing and submitting

Writing titles and abstracts. How do I structure my paper? Techniques for getting writing. How do I submit my paper? What happens next? Being a peer reviewer/responding to peer review.

Session three: Conference abstracts and posters

Dates: 6th December, 2023; 3rd May, 2024

How do I respond to conference calls for abstracts? How are presentations and posters different? What do I need to think about and how do I do it?

Session four: Drop-in support with writing

Dates: 19th January, 2024; 13th June 2024
