Who are these for?

Anyone, but especially those without experience of publishing or who would like to share and build on the experience they have. You don't have to attend all, pick what will be most useful to you. The focus will be on publishing Education/pedagogical research although all sessions are about transferable skills.

Session one: Journal articles, getting started

Dates: Thursday 26th September, 2024, 4-5; Wednesday 8th January, 2025, 3-4

What have I done that can I write about? How do I choose a journal? What skills do I need? Should I write on my own or with others? How do I know what the journal wants me to do? What else can I do to prepare?

Session two: Journal articles, writing and submitting

Dates: Tuesday 29th October 2024, 12-1; Tuesday 11th February 2025, 3.30-4.30

Writing titles and abstracts. How do I structure my paper? Techniques for getting writing. How do I submit my paper? What happens next? Being a peer reviewer/responding to peer review.

Session three: Conference abstracts and posters

Dates: Thursday 5th December, 2024, 2-3; Tuesday 18th March 2025, 10-11

How do I respond to conference calls for abstracts? How are presentations and posters different? What do I need to think about and how do I do it?

These workshops will be held approximately every five weeks as a rolling programme (three sessions, repeated).

Sessions are drop-in – no need to book. All sessions are on a Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday, times vary.
