As the brilliant GP tutors of Bristol, I would be incredibly grateful for your input in this **new research study shaping a new interdisciplinary learning package between women's health and primary care**. Your insights will play a vital role in developing and improving teaching, to bridge the gap between primary and secondary care.

We are conducting a Delphi consensus study to explore and enhance interdisciplinary learning between specialties in healthcare, within the MB21 curriculum at Bristol Medical School.

What is Interdisciplinary education and why is it important?

Interdisciplinary education involves different medical specialties collaborate in teaching. These are essential skills for medical students to navigate an increasingly complex health system where an integrated approach from multiple specialities is required to ensure holistic, coordinated, and patient-centred care.

What it involves

We invite you to participate in a series of surveys aimed at building consensus on critical topics in interdisciplinary education. Your participation will involve responding to three rounds of online surveys:

- **Round 1:** Eight open-ended questions about your opinions on interdisciplinary education and how it should be taught to undergraduates (15 minutes).
- **Round 2:** Likert scale questions to reach a consensus on developing the interdisciplinary learning package (10 minutes).
- **Round 3:** Review the final teaching package, including a Likert scale for agreement and an open-ended question for feedback (5 minutes)
