## INTRODUCTION

PARIP — Practice as Research in Performance is a five-year, AHRC\*-funded project directed by Professor Baz Kershaw and the Department of Drama: Theatre, Film, Television at the University of Bristol.

PARIP investigates creative-academic issues raised by practice as research across the performance media: dance, film, television, video, digital media and theatre. The project is

- identifying a range of PaR processes and activities in UK and European higher education institutions and producing a database of materials for use by the communities;
- investigating key questions raised by practice as research and developing a diverse range of case studies in PAR to produce knowledges surrounding issues of evaluation;
- consulting on and realizing a series of creative projects to advance potential uses of digital technologies for documentation and dissemination.
